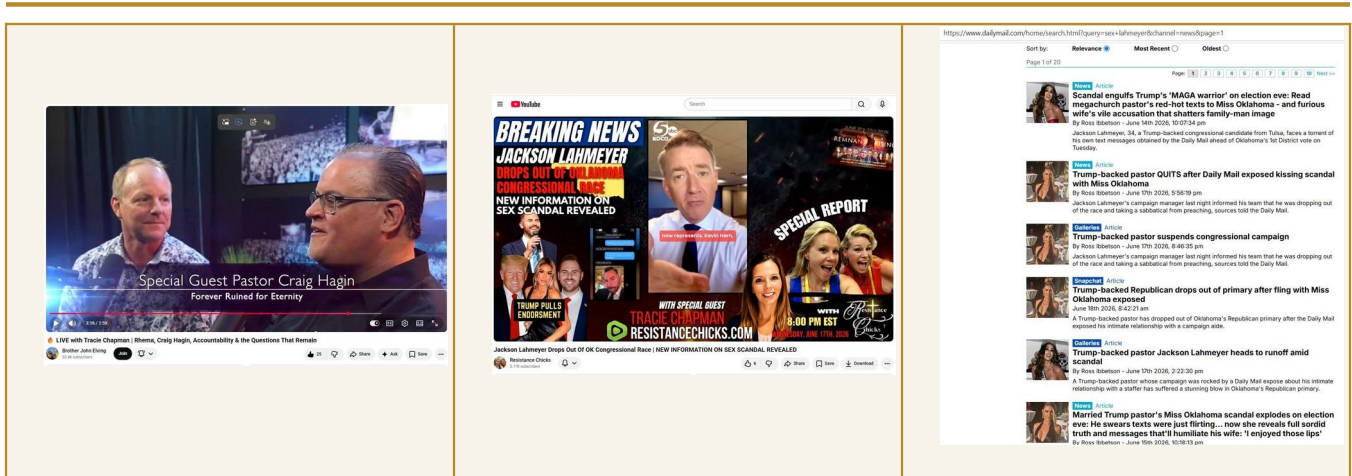

A Note of Appreciation

This recognition document honors the media voices reflected in the attached source screenshots for giving space to interviews, reporting, discussion, or updates while the larger public conversation was still developing.

Why This Recognition Matters

- Early coverage can create room for witnesses, survivors, advocates, and community members to speak without being dismissed as isolated voices.
- Independent outlets and established news organizations play different roles, but each can contribute to public awareness by documenting what is being said, asking follow-up questions, and preserving a public record.
- Recognition does not mean Oklahoma Child Wellbeing adopts every opinion, conclusion, or framing used by a featured platform. It acknowledges the decision to engage publicly with issues that deserved scrutiny.

Recognition Standard

The platforms named in this document are recognized based on source materials provided to Oklahoma Child Wellbeing showing that they published, hosted, or highlighted coverage connected to the developing public conversation. This is a statement of appreciation and civic recognition, not a legal finding or endorsement of all content appearing on any outlet.

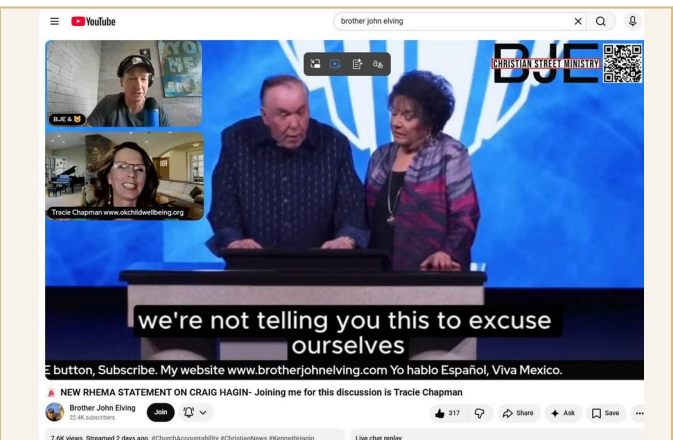

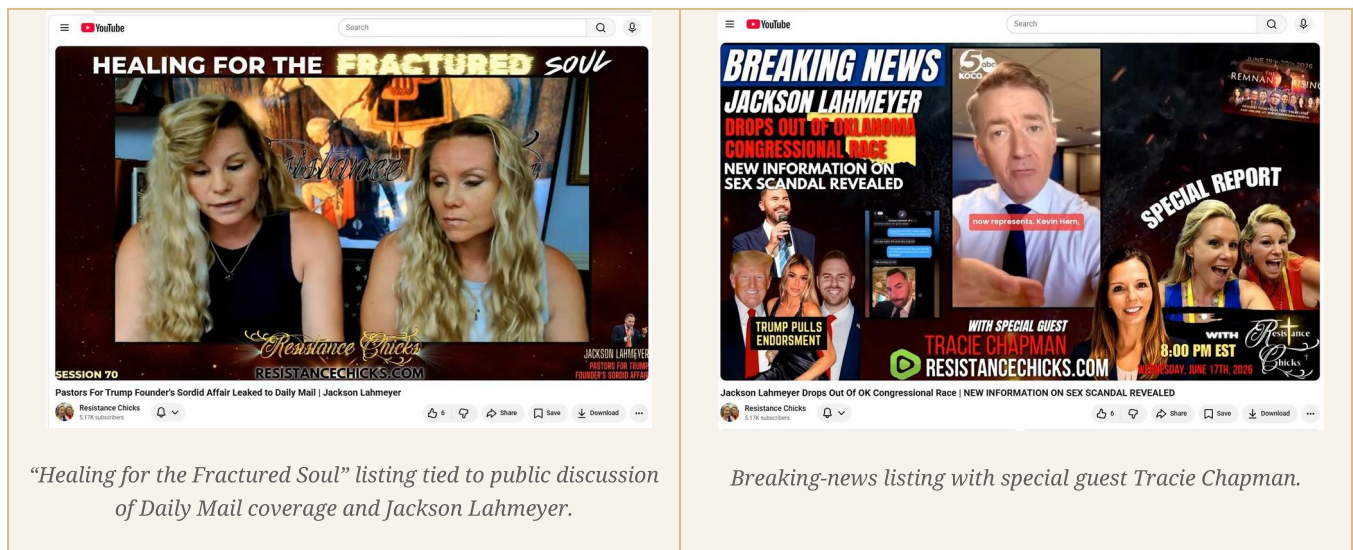

The materials show the outlet publishing beyond a single appearance and maintaining a forum for discussion.

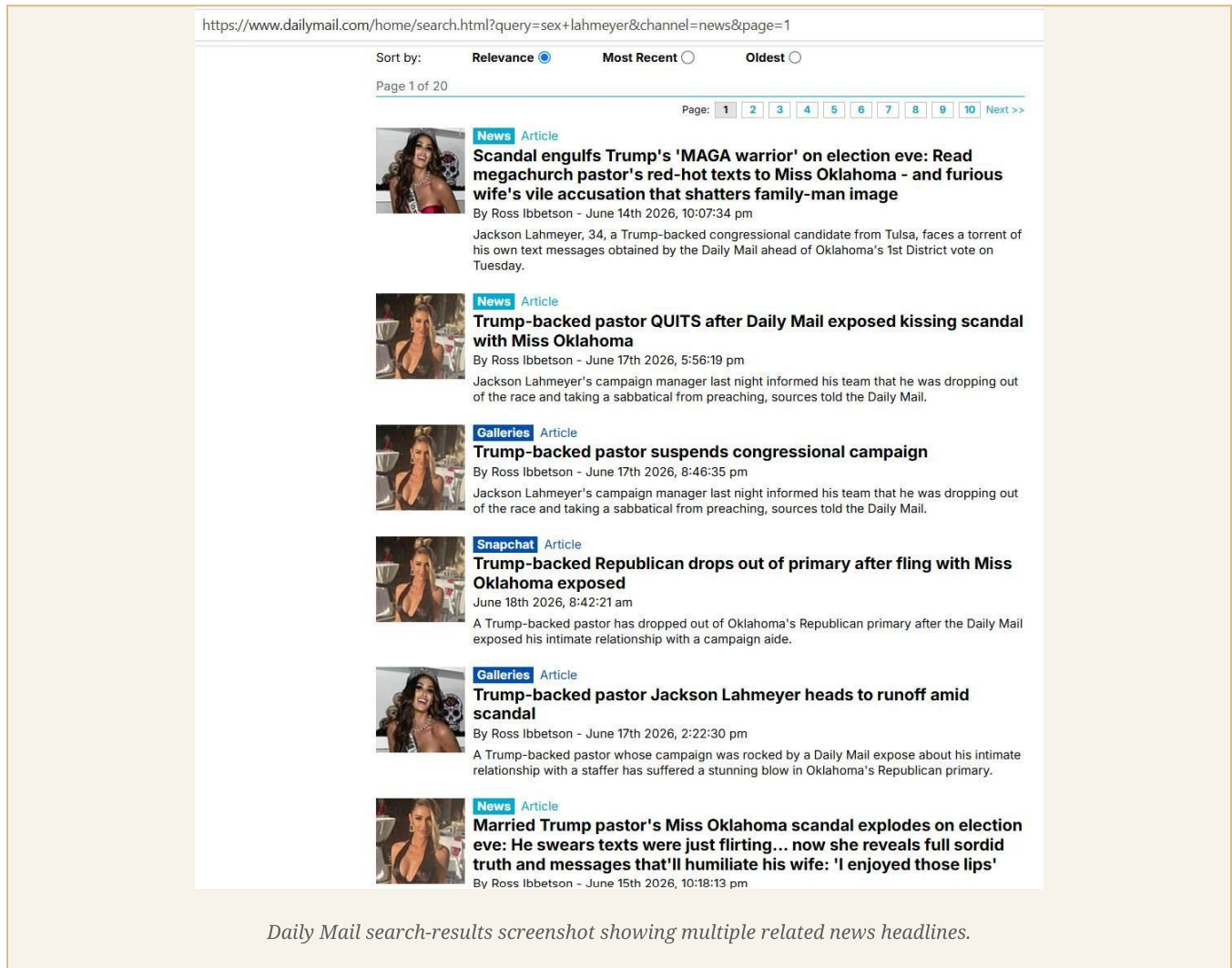
