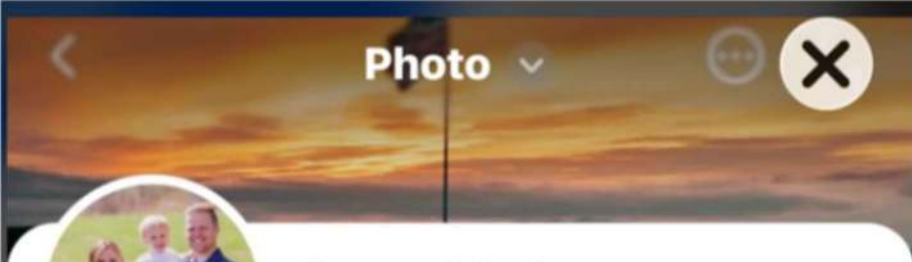
## Iron County Republicans

## WHAT IS AN 'AMERICAN GOSPEL'?

We believe American culture has distorted the gospel, creating what we call an "American Gospel." This corruption occurs in two ways: by adding promises of the "American dream" (health, wealth, and prosperity) or by subtracting core truths due to postmodernism, relativism, and religious pluralism. **The New Apostolic Reformation (NAR) is a controversial Christian movement emphasizing modern apostles and prophets, spiritual warfare, and societal influence to establish Christian dominion.**

## Overview

The **New Apostolic Reformation (NAR)** is a movement within charismatic and Pentecostal Christianity that seeks to restore the offices of apostles and prophets in church leadership, claiming these roles are being divinely restored for the modern church [w/ Wikipedia+1](#) . It was coined and popularized by **C. Peter Wagner**, who described it as a radical shift in church practice comparable to the Protestant Reformation [w/ Wikipedia](#) . NAR is not a formal denomination and lacks centralized membership, instead operating through networks of independent churches and ministries [f/ Crosswalk](#) .

## Beliefs and Practices

NAR emphasizes:

- **Five-fold ministry:** apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers, with modern apostles and prophets holding high authority [w/ Wikipedia+1](#) .
- **Spiritual gifts and direct revelations:** leaders claim ongoing divine guidance and supernatural experiences that inform church direction [f/ Crosswalk](#) .

Critics argue that NAR teachings depart from traditional Christianity by prioritizing modern apostles over Scripture and promoting political involvement as part of God’s mission [f/ Crosswalk+1](#) .

### **Historical Context**

Christian nationalism has deep roots in U.S. history. Early forms included Puritan millennialism, Christian Republicanism during the American Revolution, and the concept of Manifest Destiny in the 19th century. In the 20th century, movements like the Moral Majority and the Christian Right mobilized politically to influence elections and policy, linking Evangelical Christianity with American exceptionalism [Middle Tennessee State University](#) . In recent decades, figures like Donald Trump have been associated with the resurgence of Christian nationalist influence, including support for Supreme Court appointments and public events like the "Rededicate 250" prayer gathering [Democracy Now! +1](#) .

### **Contemporary Political Influence**

Surveys indicate that about one-third of Americans identify as Christian nationalist Adherents (11%) or Sympathizers (21%), with higher prevalence among white evangelical Protestants and Hispanic Protestants [prri.org +1](#) . Christian nationalists often support policies that reinforce traditional social hierarchies, ethno-racial boundaries, and conservative family structures, and they may favor strong leaders who can enforce these ideals [kettering.org](#) . ## Legal and Constitutional Considerations

Christian nationalism raises questions about the First Amendment, particularly the Establishment Clause, which prohibits the government from establishing a religion, and the Free Exercise Clause, which protects religious practice. While individuals are free to hold Christian nationalist beliefs, government actions that enforce or promote a specific religion can conflict with constitutional principles. Recent Supreme Court decisions have expanded the scope for religious expression in public spaces, affecting how Christian nationalist policies are implemented [legalclarity.org +1](#) .

## Theological Critiques

Many theologians argue that Christian nationalism distorts the church's mission by conflating faith with political power. It can marginalize non-Christians and reduce Christianity to a tool for social or political control, rather than a spiritual commitment [Christianity](#) . Critics emphasize that true Christian discipleship prioritizes allegiance to Christ over national or political identity.

## Global Context

Christian nationalism is not unique to the U.S.; it appears in countries like Hungary, Poland, Brazil, and Ghana, often linked to conservative social policies, anti-LGBTQ+ stances, and ethno-religious identity politics [Wikipedia](#) . Its manifestations vary by country but generally involve promoting Christianity as central to national identity and governance.

Christian nationalism, therefore, represents a complex intersection of religion, politics, and culture, with significant implications for democracy, civil rights, and religious pluralism.



### The Five Key Elements that Define the "Christianity" of Christian Nationalism

*A Desire for a Traditional Social Hierarchy.* Christian nationalism prefers a nation with certain people at the top, some in the middle, and then the rest at the bottom. These social hierarchies revolve around gender, sexuality, and family structure. The idea is that the United States will be strongest if [men lead](#) while women support, [marriage](#) is reserved for men and women, only two genders are recognized, children are raised in homes with their biological mother and father, and families commit to [having](#) large families.

Those who represent this ideal will enjoy easy access to the benefits of citizenship. Those who do not will be denied access. Nations that order their society accordingly will flourish. Those that do not will fall out of God's blessing.

This cultural commitment is signaled in Project 2025. The [third goal](#) for the Department of Health and Human Services is labeled "Promoting Stable and Flourishing Married Families." Page 451 of the *Mandate for Leadership* states, "Families comprised of a married mother, father, and their children are the foundation of a well-ordered nation and healthy society." It calls for the next Secretary of Health and Human Services to [support policies](#) "encouraging marriage, work, motherhood, fatherhood, and nuclear families" (284) while stating LGBTQ+ equity, single-motherhood, and fatherlessness are the [root](#) of societal disarray.

*A Commitment to Strong Ethno-Racial Boundaries around National Identity and Social Belonging.* Christian nationalism poses a specific [threat to democracy](#) as it envisions a very specific preferred citizen who is both [White](#) and a natural-born citizen. This relies on a [historical](#) narrative of the United States that believes this was the group of people who created this country, and it is this [group](#) who should enjoy the easiest access to [civil rights](#), social benefits, and political power. This narrative also reinforces the idea that racial and ethnic diversity, including the arrival of [immigrants](#) and refugees, only [weakens](#) the nation.

A key objective throughout Project 2025 is to strip away all diversity, inclusion, and equity [efforts](#) as these are viewed as weakening the federal government apparatus and discriminating against White Americans. Various executive orders and actions from the Trump administration are explicitly aimed at [fulfilling](#) these goals.

*Idealizing Free-Market Capitalism.* In response to fears surrounding "creeping socialism" around the New Deal, and later fears concerning communism, Christian leaders and wealthy [capitalists](#) promoted free-market capitalism, which emphasizes privatization, deregulation, and reduced public spending, as the Christian God's [preferred economic system](#).

Strong rules and a strong ruler are necessary to bring order out of chaos, and because the stakes of a rightly ordered society are so high, nothing—not even democracy—can stand in the way.

For this reason, Americans who embrace Christian nationalism are more likely to demand [obedience](#) to authority. When asked in a survey, respondents [agreed](#) that "because things have gotten so far off track in this country, we need a leader who is willing to break some rules if that's what it takes to set things right." These Americans are more likely to endorse [violence](#) in order to "save our country," [limit access](#) to the democratic process, and support [leaders](#) using any means necessary to achieve law and order. It is this element of Christian nationalism at work when we see the Department of Homeland Security [citing](#) Bible verses while advocating for militaristic deportation measures.

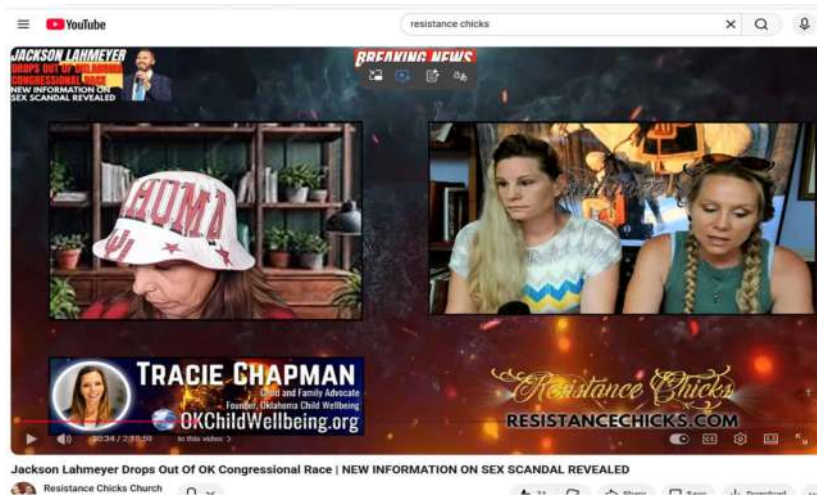

# When Faith Is Weaponized

## Domestic Violence + Spiritual Abuse

Some women are trapped not only in the traditional cycle of abuse, but also by religious coercion, shame, and community pressure.



**Domestic violence is common: more than 1 in 3 women** experienced contact sexual violence, physical violence, and/or stalking by an intimate partner in their lifetimes. (CDC, 2026)



**More than half of female homicide victims are killed by a current or former male intimate partner.** (CDC, 2026)








**Intimate partner violence has a lifetime economic cost of \$3.6 trillion in the U.S.** (CDC, 2026)

### Why women feel stuck

-  Fear of escalation or lethal violence
-  Children, housing, and financial dependence
-  Losing church family or community
-  Teachings on submission, divorce, and forgiveness used against them
-  Trauma, confusion, shame, and hope for change

### What church data show

-  **64%** of Protestant pastors agree domestic or sexual violence occurs in the lives of people in their congregation. (Lifeway, 2018)
-  **50%** of Protestant pastors say they do not have sufficient training to address sexual or domestic abuse. (Lifeway, 2018)
-  **77%** say they speak about domestic violence at least once a year. (Lifeway, 2018)
-  Available Protestant comparison, not victim prevalence: among pastors aware of #MeToo, **49%** of mainline pastors vs. **32%** of evangelical pastors said they were inclined to preach more about domestic and sexual violence. (Lifeway, 2018)

*Denomination-specific national victim prevalence data are limited; the comparison above reflects Protestant pastor survey responses, not victim prevalence.*

**A survivor may be trapped by both domestic violence and faith-based coercive control. Safety must come before image, silence, or forced reconciliation.**
