Executive Summary

Kenneth Wayne Hagin, commonly known as Kenneth W. Hagin or Kenneth Hagin Jr., is the son of Kenneth E. Hagin and Lois Oretha Rooker Hagin. Official Rhema sources identify him as president of Kenneth Hagin Ministries and senior pastor of Rhema Bible Church, and describe his work organizing Rhema Bible Training Centers, serving as international director of RHEMA Ministerial Association International, hosting A Call to Arms, and cohosting Rhema Praise and Rhema for Today with his wife, Carol Lynette Tipton Hagin.

The evidence file establishes a well-documented career progression from Army service in the early-to-mid 1960s, through home-office management and associate-pastor work in Garland, Texas, to senior leadership in the Broken Arrow-based Rhema system. The public record supports a large organizational footprint. It does not, by itself, establish his personal ownership of Rhema/KHM assets.
