****Before You Hit Send****

When someone writes an email to a married pastor that references violence toward his wife, the content deserves to be taken seriously—but it's important not to jump to conclusions about the writer's character or motives based on the email alone.

Communications like this can reflect many possibilities: anger, fear, emotional distress, an attempt to intimidate, poor judgment, a cry for attention, or even a genuine concern that is expressed in an inappropriate way. Without verified facts, assigning motives or labeling the person goes beyond what the evidence supports.

What we can say is this: any communication that references violence involving another person should be handled responsibly. It should be documented, evaluated in context, and, when appropriate, reported to the proper authorities or organizational leadership.

Protecting people and taking potential threats seriously is far more important than speculating about someone's personality.

Accountability means responding to concerning communications with wisdom, documentation, and due process—not assumptions. Safety, truth, and fairness should always guide the response.

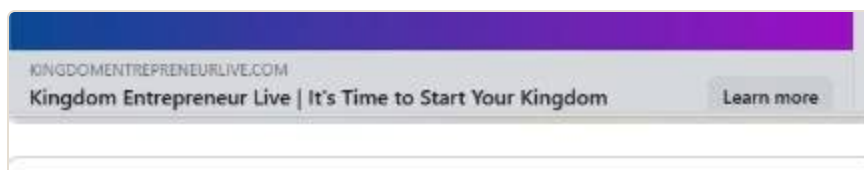

Too often, these types of marketing campaigns appeal to individuals who are already struggling financially or searching for purpose.

Celebrity endorsements can create an impression of credibility that encourages people to spend money on courses, coaching, or memberships they may not be able to afford. Families facing financial hardship deserve transparent information about the actual costs, risks, and success rates—not just inspiring testimonials and motivational messaging.

There is nothing wrong with entrepreneurship or helping people build businesses. But there should also be clear disclosures, realistic expectations, and accountability when marketing opportunities to the public, especially when faith, purpose, or personal calling are part of the sales message.

Public figures have significant influence. With that influence comes a responsibility to ensure that the opportunities they promote are transparent, ethical, and do not create unrealistic expectations for the very people who are hoping for a better future.

Bait and switch. Pipe dreams. Get-rich-quick promises.

Some marketing campaigns don't just sell a product—they sell hope. They promise financial freedom, purpose, and a better life, only for many people to discover that the reality doesn't match the pitch.

The people most often drawn to these opportunities are not the wealthy. They are working families, single parents, retirees, veterans, and people trying to escape financial stress. They work hard, sacrifice, and invest money they can barely afford to lose because they genuinely want a better future for themselves and their children.

There is nothing wrong with entrepreneurship or building a business. But there is a difference between teaching someone how to succeed and selling an unrealistic dream without clearly communicating the costs, risks, and the fact that most participants may never achieve the lifestyle being advertised.

Transparency matters. If an opportunity is legitimate, it should be able to stand on honest disclosures, realistic expectations, and verifiable outcomes—not emotional appeals, celebrity endorsements, or the fear of missing out.

America's hardest-working families deserve respect, not marketing that preys on their hopes. Opportunity should be built on truth, ethics, and accountability—not on promises that are unlikely to become reality for most participants.

YIKES: RHEMA DAYCARE in TULSA Oklahoma we have questions:

A new concern came in today. **Broken Arrow Sentinel**

"Rhema's daycare was recently shut down for several days to take care of an extensive mold problem that threatened the health and safety of the children and workers. My understanding is that an entire portion of the building had to be cleared out.

While it's true that mold problems can grow for a long time without being discovered, and they likely dealt with it once it was found, I question the building safety and procedures for keeping the childcare area safe. In a place that is touted as one of the best and safest to send your young child, there must be a system to prevent and check for issues like this before it comes to this point.

Maybe Rhema is learning yet another lesson here. I question how many corners are cut and what issues are covered up in the daycare. It's another stewardship and transparency problem. Really, it seems like the same problems throughout the entire organization are just showing up in different ways.

Maybe I'm over-sensitive about this because of the other problems that have come to light. Mold happens, and it can be sneaky, but if parents were not informed, I see this as a real problem.

One of the most important questions any organization that serves children should ask is not simply, "How did this happen?" but "What systems failed to detect and prevent it?"

When issues involving building safety, environmental hazards, or other risks arise in childcare settings, parents deserve timely communication, transparency, and confidence that comprehensive inspection and maintenance procedures are in place. Organizations entrusted with the care of children have a heightened responsibility to identify and address potential hazards before they become significant problems.

This project is not about criticizing organizations for facing challenges—every organization encounters them. It is about examining whether governance, oversight, risk management, and communication practices are sufficient to protect children, families, employees, and the public's trust.

Strong institutions do not fear accountability. They demonstrate it through transparency, corrective action, continuous improvement, and a willingness to answer difficult questions. Child safety should never depend on assumptions; it should be supported by documented systems, regular oversight, and a culture that welcomes accountability.

As Oklahoma Child Wellbeing continues this public-interest research, our focus remains the same: identifying opportunities to strengthen ethics, governance, transparency, and child-serving systems so that children and families are better protected.

History of H.I.M.

From the Beginning.....

My name is Kirk DuBois, and I am the founder of Harvest International Ministries. I received Jesus Christ as my Lord in 1971 during the "Jesus Movement." I had been into drugs, the occult (before "New Age" was popular), had a juvenile police record and an unhappy family life. I had searched for God in every thinkable place, studied parapsychology, witchcraft, etc., and used hallucinogenic drugs to "help" my search. I always came up empty handed until March 9th, 1971 at about 3 o'clock in the afternoon. That's when I bowed my knees and confessed Jesus Christ as my Lord. The change was immediate and lasting. From that point on I was involved with street evangelism, beach witnessing, Bible studies, jail ministry, etc. It wasn't a question of whether or not I was "called." When I was born-again, I was born to serve (which is what the word "ministry" means.) Since that time God has continued to enlarge my steps and give me opportunity to minister for Him. During those first years, I began attending Kathryn Kuhlman meetings in Los Angeles. At those meetings I came in contact with the reality of God's Presence and power. God was dealing with me about what He wanted me to do.



In 1974, while walking in a wheat field in Oklahoma, God dealt with me about the last great harvest of souls. He spoke to me about the way people used to harvest with sickles, but how today men use



combines to reap whole fields in a short time. He said the combines are anointed ministries that will bring in the last day harvest quickly and multitudes would be saved. In 1975 I attended the Anaheim Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship International World Convention. It was there I heard Kathryn Kuhlman for the last time, and there that I heard Kenneth E. Hagin for the first time. At the last meeting I attended, Kenneth Copeland was speaking. During his altar call, the scene of me in the wheat field in Oklahoma in 1974 came back to me, and what God had said. While I was seeing this vision in my spirit, suddenly I heard Kenneth Copeland interrupt the altar call and say, "Men, I see a wheat field. And I see people trying to get the harvest in with sickles while all the time God has a whole line of combines that He wants to use to get the job done." He went on to say that the combines are anointed men that God will use in the last days. This was one of those precious times when you know God has His hand on your life!



In those years of preparation, God was doing a lot to confirm His will in my life. He has confirmed His Word that He would send me around the world to minister in the supernatural. Along the way of preparation I have graduated from Global University of the Assemblies of God, and graduated from [RHEMA Bible Training College](#) in 1991. In 2018 I received a Doctorate of Ministry degree. I have been privileged to work for Kenneth Hagin Ministries since 1982, teaching at Rhema Bible Training College since 1999 and ministered in Rhema's "Healing School."

There may have been others but I can tell you my husband talked to pastor Hagin and asked him to let RMAI handle Craig as a minister and have a restoration process. He'd need to step down.

Didn't go over well.

I went to RHEMA in 92-94 and my husband was there from 96-97. I don't remember much about the details. I do remember thinking he was a fool. I wasn't impressed with Craig during that time. I'm not sure when his marriage fell apart. Some of the rumors I heard came from Dean Hawk when he came to our church to do the youth during our "camp meeting." He had a few things to say about Craig, but it was so long ago that I don't remember the detail. I just remember Dean sharing his concerns.

VICTIM - Layers of lifelong trauma - generational-

WHEN A VICTIM'S TRAUMA IS USED AGAINST HER

One of the cruelest forms of revictimization occurs when a person's history of adversity is repackaged as evidence that she is unreliable. Comments about her finances, childhood, family, mental health,

relationships, or possible prenatal exposure do not establish that her present account is false. They redirect attention away from the reported conduct and toward the victim's perceived imperfections. A victim does not have to be financially successful, emotionally composed, or from a stable family to deserve safety, dignity, and a fair evaluation of her evidence.

Research confirms that childhood maltreatment is associated with an increased risk of victimization later in life. A systematic review found substantial evidence connecting childhood maltreatment with revictimization across the lifespan. This must never be interpreted as victims causing or inviting later abuse.

Revictimization develops through complex individual, relational, community, and structural conditions that can be exploited by people seeking power or control. The CDC likewise explains that adverse childhood experiences can affect lifelong health, relationships, opportunity, and economic stability—and that their effects can extend across generations. Trauma creates vulnerability; it does not create guilt. ([Systematic review of childhood maltreatment and revictimization](#); [CDC information on adverse childhood experiences](#))

Credibility attacks are also documented in psychological research. In experimental studies of DARVO—Deny, Attack, and Reverse Victim and Offender—people exposed to this tactic judged the victim as less believable and more responsible while viewing the alleged perpetrator as less responsible. Negative reactions to a victim's disclosure, including disbelief, blame, dismissal, and attacks on character, have also been associated with greater PTSD symptoms and harmful coping responses. Financial instability should not automatically be treated as a character flaw; economic abuse itself can leave survivors with debt, damaged credit, employment disruption, and long-term financial insecurity. A trauma-informed response protects the person's privacy, obtains informed consent, separates verified facts from rumors, and evaluates each allegation on its evidence—not on whether the victim has lived a perfect life. SAMHSA instructs organizations to actively resist retraumatization. Research on institutional betrayal similarly shows that additional harm can occur when trusted organizations fail to respond supportively after a disclosure. The correct question is not, "Is this victim flawless?" The correct questions are: "What happened, what evidence exists, who had responsibility, and was the person protected?" Imperfect victims are still victims. Trauma responses are not proof of dishonesty. A complicated history does not erase someone's right to be heard.

I grew up at Rhema and currently attend. I've been keeping up with your coverage of the ethics issues at Rhema on the Resistance Chicks and greatly commend your work.

In the episode, you mentioned Wesley Burns and the video about him talking about his salary at Rhema. I think the video you were referencing may have been from [this video](#) at Mark Hankin's leadership conference earlier this year. In case the link doesn't work, Burn's testimony starts at 35:38 and talks about his finances

towards the end. Hankins also commented support for Craig on Instagram. I've attached a screenshot to this email.

I grew up around Burns and went to college with him. I always found his pivot into ministry a bit odd. We both went to Oral Roberts University, and we had required religion classes. He and his friends always sat in the back of the auditorium and talked the whole time. He made the switch to ministry around June 2025, and the following month, he was one of the headline speakers for the youth conference. Another one of his friends, Luke Ford, was a morning speaker, despite only completing one year of RBTC at the time.

As children and teenagers, he came across very arrogant and conceded due to his family owning the church and coming from considerable wealth. He graduated from Metro Christian Academy in Tulsa, his first car was a new Lexus sedan, and as far as I'm aware, his parents bought him a new Ford F150 after he got into a car accident a few years ago. It's been a while since I last spoke him, but he was nice enough, although I don't trust it.

My friends and I always had the theory that Wesley switched to ministry since his brother and his cousins aren't as involved in the ministry, but since he doesn't have the "Hagin" name, we've been wondering how that would work. I still attend Rhema due to my parents still being involved.

I hope any of this is helpful and I would like to remain anonymous All the best,

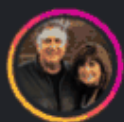

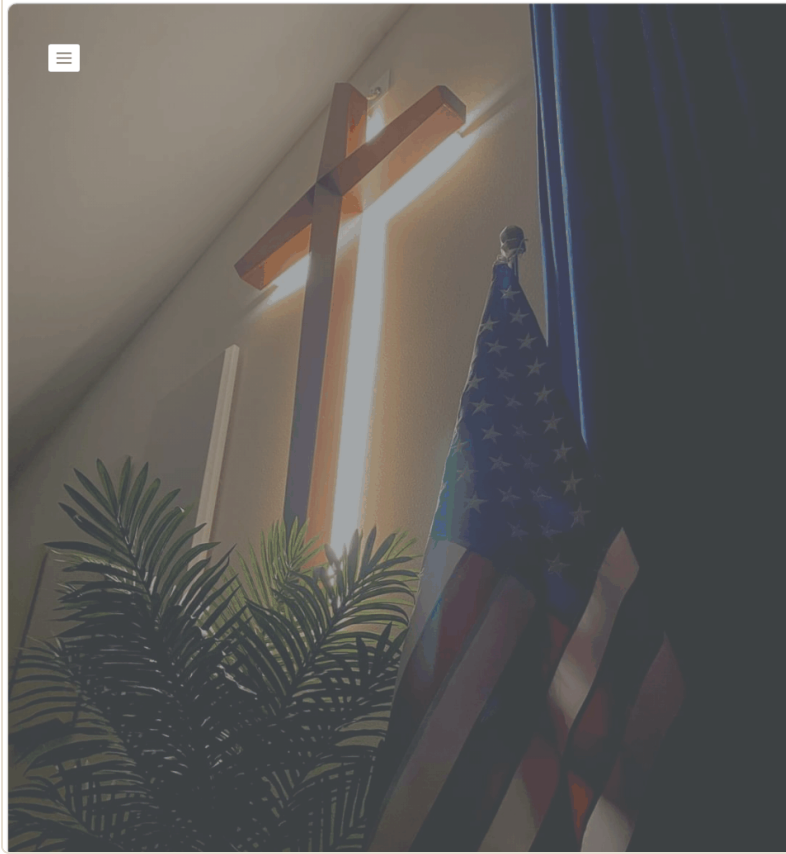
